ATTENTION: Alert!

The day and time is here! We need your help! The Coastal Bend Community Foundation (CBCF) has graciously allowed us to be among the area nonprofits benefiting through the “Day of Giving” that begins at 12:00 a.m. (midnight) on Tuesday, November 12, and ends at 11:59 p.m. EARLY giving is November 4-11. Many choose to donate early to avoid forgetting on November 12th. This may work better for YOU, too. The first \$24,000 donated is matched by CBCF and 23 co-funders. When matched, we have \$48,000 and seek to continue adding to it and hopefully, we can finally reach our goal of \$100,000.

Family Upreach, Inc. (dba NewLife Behavior Ministries) impacts all four of these areas in significant ways. Thank you for your support on November 12 and all year long!

This year marks our 10th year to have participated in event. Whatever the total ends up being, it will be the most received in one 24-hour period of the year! Here is the history of totals for the previous nine years (see the box to the left). We usually succeed in falling within the top 5-10 nonprofits participating each year. The most successful ones go well over \$100,000. A common “key” is being supported by more donors even if they do not contribute large amounts.

In recent years we have climbed up to nearly 100 donors, but the more successful nonprofits have two to five times more! Why is it important to get over the \$100,000 mark? The purpose behind CBCF sponsoring the Day of Giving is to give the smaller nonprofits (like us) a “boost” and attract new and ongoing donors who get to know and help us throughout the year and for years into the future. Also, we want to be able to continue to be counted among nonprofits invited to benefit from the Day of Giving. So, we want to prove we are being productive and need more help. A few nonprofits each year fail to reach the minimum required for the matching amount.

Approximately a year after arrival, Walker Hill—our first *Gideon Project* participant—is on his way to *Project Rescue* near Decatur, Alabama. No stranger there, it is our hope and prayer that this also means a continuation in his growth spiritually while becoming an asset to others in this good program. During his time in Corpus Christi, Walker gained experience in various facets of both NewLife Behavior and Kings Crossing Prison ministries. One of his most productive efforts has been facilitating extremely effective podcast interviews with men and women whose lives have been dramatically impacted by Christ.

Project Rescue was founded by Ronnie Crocker on 19 beautiful acres in Priceville, Alabama. Ronnie also serves as the director of this 501 c (3) ministry helping addicts through its 6-12 month program that is centered on the church, study and application of God’s Word.
