## NATIONAL JAIL & PRISON MINISTRY WORKSHOP 2025

Annually, for the last 51 years, brothers and sisters who are interested, involved, and support the mission field that is in our jails and prisons across the United States, meet once a year. This year's workshop- was in Louisville, Kentucky and was hosted by the **Midwest Church of Christ**. *John "Pooh" Malone* is the preaching minister there and *Jerry Stephenson*, a NewLife Behavior Board member and preacher emeritus, also attends at the Midwest congregation. # NEWLIFE BEHAVIOR MINISTRIES' SPANISH IMPACT

**Buck Griffith** has been working with **Mayra Melendez** for several years on getting all of the NLB courses translated into Spanish. We discovered Mayra and her translating talents through a relationship with **Luis Melendez** who is part of the missions staff at the **Sunset International Bible Institute** (SIBI).

Some of our courses were translated back in 2008, but we found that the work done at the time was not as proficient as needed. In other languages, choosing which words to capture the meaning of a word or phrase in

English can change the entire meaning of a thought or even make a sentence nonsensical. With Mayra's assistance we have a quality translation of NLB courses in Spanish that is being used in jails and prisons across the country. It has also caught the attention of churches and ministries south of the U.S. border.

Normally, NLBM works within the borders of the United States and our sister organization, **NewLlife Behavior International** (NLBI), works in countries outside of the United States. NLBI has a strong presence in Africa, but



we have not experienced the same impact in Central and South America. That may be changing.

We have been asked to speak with the **Nicaragua International Bible Institute (NIBI)** in Managua, Nicaragua. Like SIBI, NIBI is also a preacher training school. In addition, several churches that impact this area of Central America will also be present. **Dr. Dale Underwood** will travel to Nicaragua July 24<sup>th</sup> through 29<sup>th</sup> to carry the Newlife Behavior Spanish curricula to NIBI. Please pray that the years of work in translating NLB courses into Spanish will bear much fruit and help the churches in Central and South America.
